The purpose of the institution is to impart education to economically backward, downtrodden and weaker sections of the society irrespective of the caste, creed, sex and religion. The growth of institution during the past 100 years is noteworthy with its motto “Tejo Si Tejo me Dehi.” New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Parner is one of the active educational institute working in the rural area since 1977. The college has continuously upgraded its academic profile with new academic programmes as per the need of the time and to make available the new avenues of career options to students.

“If a poor boy cannot go to education, education must go to him”

This quote by swami Vivekananda reminds us about our responsibility towards providing education to all. All of us are created equally but after the birth we are divided into caste, religion and status. Some get privileged while others left scrambling for even the basic needs of the survival. We have the sense of responsibility for the betterment of those less fortunate. In the fight against this poverty and inequality, education is our biggest asset. Therefore in order to encourage and motivate such talent in the students, HEI has made separate budgetary provision to offers financial assistance to students from financially weaker section to pursue education and appreciate their achievements in academics, sports, cultural and extension activities.

Every year after a short notification in the month of September, the applications are invited from the students who are poor, financially weaker and who has lost his/her father or mother. This application should be enclosed with valid documents like admission receipt, income certificate, ration card and death certificate of their either parents. These applications are scrutinized by a committee constituted by Hon. Principle and list of students availing the scholarship are then declared. Following is the summary of our efforts in this area:
