

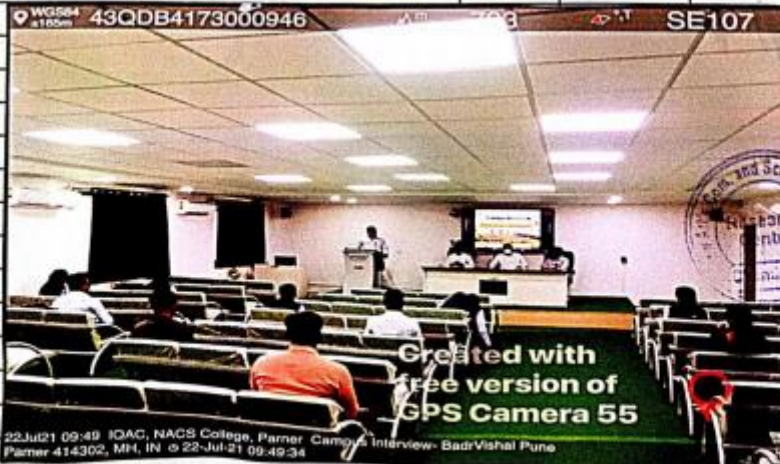



## Report

IQAC and Swayam Local Chapter, New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Parner organised One Day workshop on “How to enroll Swayam and NPTEL courses?” on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 at Virtual Classroom to train teachers, mentors and students through online and offline mode. The objective of this workshop is to create awareness about SWAYAM and NPTEL courses. It also provides an opportunity to teachers to discuss how to introduce courses through SWAYAM Local Chapter, content development process and certification of the courses. There are total 52 participants participated in this workshop.

In the Inaugural session, Dr. Dilip Thube introduced the theme of workshop, outline of the programme and for what this workshop is being organised. The workshop is inaugurated by honourable Principal Dr. Rangnath Aher. In his inaugural speech, he highlighted the importance of online courses to students, mentors and faculties. He also highlighted the timely need of the MOOCs. He also encouraged the participants to enroll for these courses and enrich their knowledge. He also advised faculties to identify online courses and admit nearly all students for at least one course to impart quality education as well strengthen SWAYAM Local Chapter.

In the Second Session, Bhausaheb Narasale , the resource person for the workshop, made participants aware of the importance of SWAYM and other online platforms which enrich knowledge in this pandemic situation. SWAYAM is a programme initiated by the Government of India and designed to achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy viz., access, equity and quality. The objective of this effort is to take the best teaching learning resources to all, including the most disadvantaged. SWAYAM seeks to bridge the digital divide for students who have hitherto remained untouched by the digital revolution and have not been able to join the mainstream of the knowledge economy. Courses delivered through SWAYAM are available free of cost to the learners, however learners wanting a SWAYAM certificate should register for the final proctored exams that come at a fee and attend in-person at

designated centres on specified dates. Eligibility for the certificate will be announced on the course page and learners will get certificates only if this criteria is matched. Universities/colleges approving credit transfer for these courses can use the marks/certificate obtained in these courses for the same. National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) is a project of MHRD initiated by seven Indian Institutes of Technology (Bombay, Delhi, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, Guwahati and Roorkee) along with the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 2003, to provide quality education to anyone interested in learning from the IITs. The main goal was to create web and video courses in all major branches of engineering and physical sciences at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels and management courses at the postgraduate level. He also interacted with participants.

In the third session, there is a panel discussion. Dr. Sukhdev Kadam, Dr. Vijay Raut, Virendra Dhanashetti, Dr. T.S. Thopate, Dr.R.N. Deshmukh, Dr. Raghunath Najan , Dr. S.R. Wagh, Dr. Haresh Shelke, Dr. B. J. Kakade, Dr, Yuvraj Waghere, Ranjit Shinde and other participants actively participated in the discussion. There is interaction with the participants on the implementation issues related to the introduction of online learning courses in the Curriculum.

**Ph. D. Course Work Report**




In this workshop the resource person spoke about the sources constituting Electronic Waste which contain the following points:
