9. To avail a network for bridging the communication gap between the management and students.

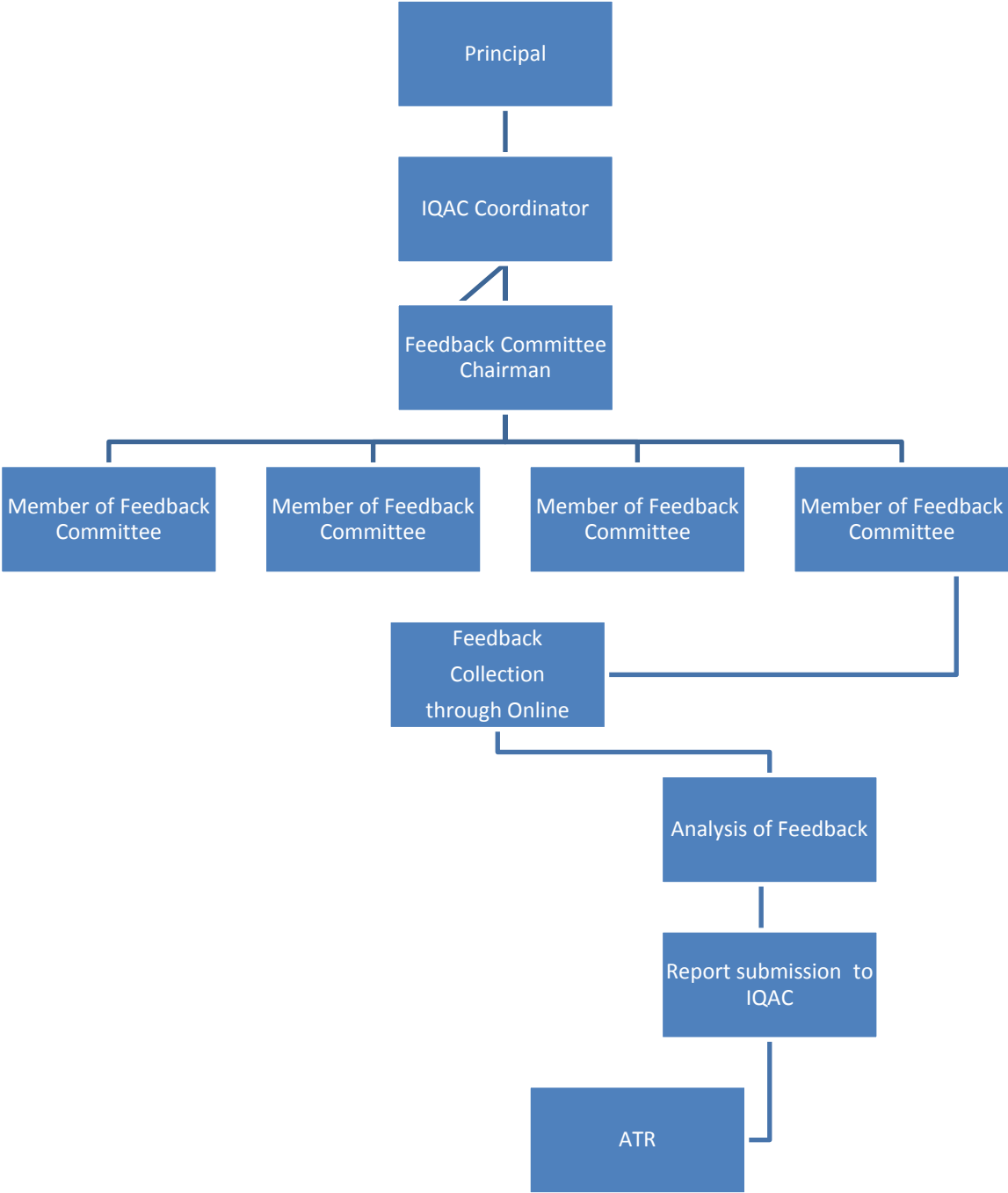
Role and Responsibilities:

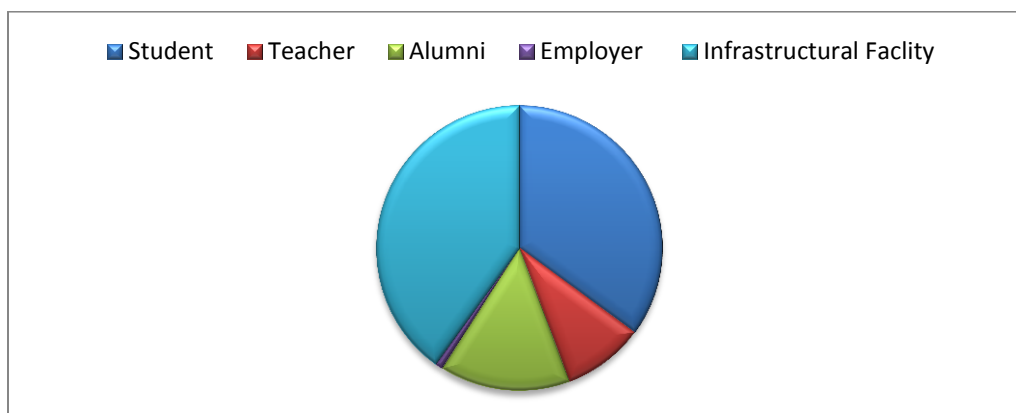
Feedback Report:

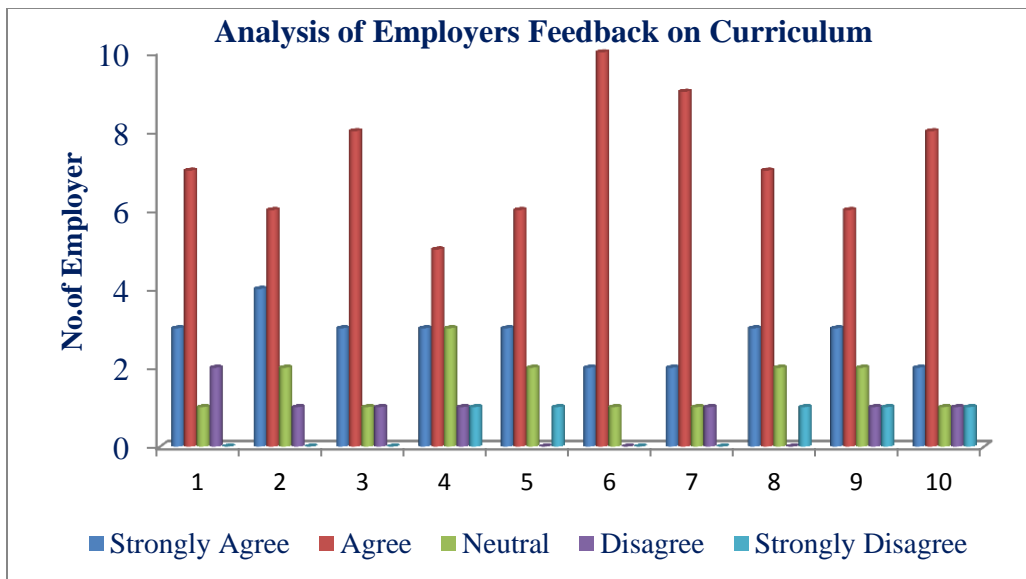
1. The suggestions regarding curriculum are communicated to affiliating university authorities through respective Board of Studies and for certificate courses it is used for improvement

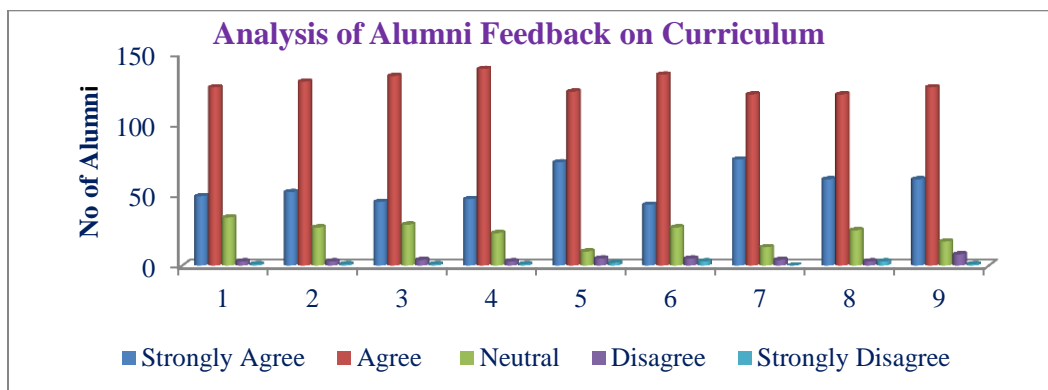
Following are the generous suggestions from the alumni of the college:

Graphical representation of feedback given by alumni:

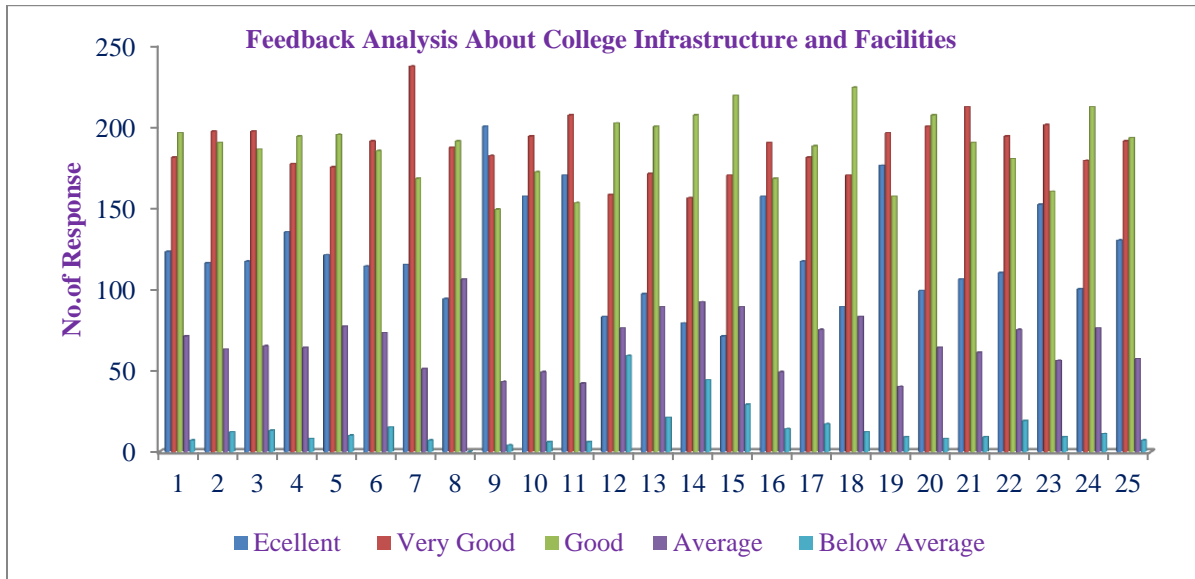


e) Feedback on Infrastructural Facility of the College:
