- 9. To avail a network for bridging the communication gap between the management and students.


#### **Role and Responsibilities:**


#### **Feedback Report:**

#### a) Feedback from Students:


Feedback on teaching and learning process has been submitted by 506 students for the academic year 2020-21. The following table is showing the different views of students regarding the teaching learning process

#### **Graphical representation of responses received from students:**




#### b) Feedback from Teachers:

#### **Graphical representation of responses received from teachers:**




#### c) Feedback from Employers:


Following are the generous suggestions from the alumni of the college:

have given their very good responses and 34 percent responses recorded for good response regarding infrastructural facilities which is available in the college. The following table is showing the different views and their graphical representation.


Following are generous suggestion for the excellence of the college:
