## Scholarship/ Student Aid Fund for Indigent Student

### Introduction:

Chhatrapati Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj of Kolhapur was a source of inspiration to the institution. The institute established in 1918, namely “Ahmednagar Jilha Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj”. The purpose of the institution is to impart education to economically backward, downtrodden and weaker sections of the society irrespective of the caste, creed, sex and religion. The growth of institution during the past 100 years is noteworthy with its motto “*Tejo Si Tejo me Dehi*” New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Parner is one of the active educational institute working in the rural area since 1977. The college has continuously upgraded its academic profile with new academic programmes as per the need of the time and to make available the new avenues of career options to students.

### Scope:

Therefore in order to encourage and motivate such talent in the students, HEI is very cautious to assist student for availing scholarships through various schemes and scholarships of state and central government.

HEI has also made commendable efforts to provide the financial assistance indigent to students from financially weaker section to pursue education and appreciate their achievements in academics, sports, cultural and extension activities.



## **Objectives:**

1. To motivate and encourage the students from deprived sections to continue uninterrupted higher education at HEI by availing scholarships.
2. To create awareness about the various schemes and scholarships of state and central government.
3. To assist the student for application to a common portal for various scholarships/schemes of Central and State Governments.
4. To ensure a transparent database of scholars and to avoid duplication in processing through scrutiny at institutional level.
5. To forward the applications to concern authority for Direct Benefit Transfer.
6. To sort out any grievances regarding scholarships.

## **Guiding Principles:**

### **A. Schemes of State and Central Government**

1. Organization of events for awareness about various scholarship and schemes of State and Central Government.
2. Circulation of notifications of relevant scholarship and schemes.
3. Provide support to students for online applications and required documents to these scholarships and schemes.
4. Facilitation and Scrutinization of the applications at institutional level on timely basis.
5. Ensure timely disbursement of Scholarships to students.
6. Initiation of measure to find out solutions to any grievances regarding scholarships.

### **B. Student Aid Fund for Indigent Student:**

Every year after a short notification in the month of September, the applications are invited from the students who are poor, financially weaker and who has lost his/her father or mother. This application should be enclosed with valid documents like admission receipt, income certificate, ration card and death certificate of their either parents. These applications are scrutinized by a committee constituted by Hon. Principal and list of students availing the scholarship are then declared.



## Outcomes and Benefits:

With the advent of this financial assistance, it has been found that students have done very well in their academic goals. This has resulted in incremental growth in the enrolment of the student. HEI has taken all the efforts by regular review of this scheme to reach and support maximum number of needy, indigent and poor students.
