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1. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

Internal Quality Assurance Cell is established in college to inculcate and sustain the quality culture. As quality enhancement is a continuous process, the IQAC is contributing for developing strategies and initiatives for quality enhancement & sustenance. It has become an integral part of the system of HEI.

IQAC is involved in planning, guiding, and monitoring quality assurance and enhancement activities. It is tremendously contributing for institutionalizing the quality culture strategies and processes viz., academic calendar, perspective plan, admission process, strengthening of teaching-learning process, evaluations, measuring learning outcomes, research activities, extension activities, sports, cultural enhancements, and quality sustenance initiatives. IQAC framed 26 policies and procedures considering NAAC recommendations and channelized its efforts to ensure quality education. IQAC has catalysed the improvements in the overall performance of institutions.

The comprehensive strategies initiated during last five years are:

- 1. A Perspective plan is prepared through discussion with stakeholders
- 2. Admissions and administration processes are practiced using e-governance.
- 3. Various committees have been framed and ensured the participatory functioning in the quality processes.
- 4. SIP-Students' Mentoring programmes are conducted and mentoring is continuously practiced.
- 5. Teacher Induction and Training Programmes for staff are conducted.
- 6. Faculties and students are guided for credit system through Training for CBCS.
- 7. ICT facilities are enhanced and faculties are empowered to make efficiently and regularly.
- 8. E-Contents are developed by faculties and used at large scale during pandemic.
- 9. Programme outcomes (PO) and course outcomes (CO) are defined, stated, displayed on website. The attainment levels are evaluated using a well-defined procedure.
- 10. Career Guidance and Placement cell is established with an Officer, placement activities are increased to enhance placements.
- 11. Faculties are continuously encouraged for quality research through collaborations/linkages established. Research articles and patents are published.
- 12. Faculties are guided for promotions using Performance Appraisal System. HEI has 6 professor and 6 associate professors.
- 13. New Programmes on VET: BVoc are initiated.
- 14. Workshops and seminars are organized at national and international level.
- 15. Awareness about National Education Policy NEP-2020 is created among stakeholders through workshops and seminars.
- 16. Funds are generated through proposals from UGC, DST, and RUSA for infrastructure augmentation and utilized efficiently.
- 17. Students are encouraged for participation in sports and cultural activities.
- 18. Feedback and SSS mechanism is established and implemented regularly for improvements.

- 19. Quality audits: AAA, Green, Energy and Electrical Safety audits are conducted periodically
- 20. Gender sensitization and Woman empowerment activities are conducted regularly.
- 21. Representation of Teachers on academic bodies is increased.
- 22. Quality accreditations: AISHE, NIRF, ARIIA, ISO and NAAC
- 23. Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR) prepared and submitted every year in time.

Significant achievements during last 5 years:

- 1. Student-centric outcome oriented teaching-learning is practiced in context with 'Rise by Learning'. Skills oriented certificate courses increased. Student centric approach allows experiential and participative learning through projects, training and employability enhancing programmes.
- 2. Teacher maintains a course file which contains the academic planning, syllabus, teaching plan, COs-POs, attendance, question papers, marks-lists, course completion reports and outcome attainments.
- 3. Library-ILMS with latest books, references, e-books, access to e-journals is offered to staff.
- 4. Induction programmes conducted enhances the work culture values and ethics.
- 5. Training programmes have been conducted for staff, to train them with new pedagogies in academic and administration.
- 6. Involvement of faculties has been increased in participating workshops, conferences, seminars, FDPs, and number is increased by 229.
- 7. University rank achievers 95, 1069 higher progressions and 457 placements. Degree convocation programmes are conducted at college level for the benefit of students.
- 8. NPTEL SWAYAM Local chapter is established for online learning of teachers and 895 students enrolled.
- 9. Faculties have developed more than 2000 e-contents. These are available on college website for all stakeholders and helped a lot during pandemic.
- 10. College promoted research culture by organizing research methodology, IPR workshops and guidance talks of experts and established IIC, Innovation and Start-up cell. During 5 years number of faculties holding PhD has increased to 29, recognized research centres with PhD programme are 4, 16 guides in college, 37 PhDs are registered and 7 PhDs, 3 MPhils have been awarded through expert guidance of faculties.
- 11. Faculties published 237 journal articles, 2 copyrights and 5 patents during assessment period.
- 12. MoUs and collaborations with institutions of national/international importance, industries have increased to 53.
- 13. Awards for performances of faculties and institute are reached to 50.
- 14. State-of-the-art infrastructure is established for maintaining learning ambience.

Report

IQAC, New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Parner organised a One Day workshop on "National Education Policy (NEP-2020)" on Friday, 4th March, 2022 at Dr. A.P. J. Abdul Kalam auditorium. The objective of this workshop is to acquaint students with New Education Policy (NEP-2020). It also provides an opportunity to teachers and students to discuss the nature of the new education policy to be implemented very soon. There are a total 258 participants in this workshop.

In the Inaugural session, Dr. Rangnath Aher introduced the theme of workshop, outline of the programme and for what this workshop is being organised. Dr. Dilip Thube introduced the chief guest and resource person for the Workshop. The workshop is inaugurated by honourable Principal Dr.N.S. Umrani, Pro Vice- Chancellor, SPPU, Pune. In his inaugural speech, he said that change is inevitable. We need to change with changing time to adapt with new changes and so we must accept blending of courses and interdisciplinary approach. He also advised faculties and students to be adept with the newly introduced National Education Policy for the best and multiple career opportunities.

In the Second Session, Dr. M. G. Chaskar, Dean, Science Faculty, SPPU, Pune, the resource person for the workshop, introduced participants to the need of New Education Policy. Dr. Dilip R. Thube chaired the session. Dr. M.G. Chaskar also cited examples of ancient Indian Universities i.e. Takshashila and Nalanda. Interdisciplinary approach is not new one but it has its origin in our ancient universities. He also explained the concept of Liberal Education. There is freedom for students to choose courses without any limitations. The students of science faculty can opt for the courses of arts and commerce faculty or Vice-versa. There is flexibility and freedom to students in choosing subjects.

In the third session, Dr. N.S. Umarani, Pro Vice- Chancellor, SPPU, Pune highlighted the need to read, study and contemplate New Education Policy. Dr. Rangnath Aher chaired the session. Dr. N.S. Umarani also stressed the need to prepare a plan of action for implementation of the New Education Policy. If we execute the plan of action, there will be the best result. The pandemic is now almost coming to an end and we need to Begin Again. We need to consider the aspirations and expectations of the students and built-up bridge between them. We need to sustain the quality of education and try our best to give education beyond formal education. There must be access, equity and quality. We must set up teaching objectives, learning objectives and its outcome. We need to consider accountability and affordability of education we impart to students. We need to increase productivity and transparency. The college development committee has to play an important role to increase resources and avail grants for the projects. There is a need to raise funds for poor and needy students. The students have to opt for major and minor subjects with a keen desire to learn new and innovative things. It will lead to all round development of the students and they will be the best citizens of the nation. They must know and familiar with the law, tradition, practices and culture of the nation they belong to. They must be able to think and act rationally. The students must be compassionate, empathetic, having courage, credibility, scientific approach and cherish values. He also introduced the new concept Industry 4.0 which includes artificial intelligence. The aim of education is to produce productive citizens to create new communities as per the constitution of our nation.

He also highlighted the principles of New Education Policy. Education must have flexibility, multi-disciplinary approach, creative and critical thinking, conceptual understanding and continuous evaluation. Assessment should be summative rather than formative. The students must learn and practice ethics and human values. They must master life skills. We need to build a standard education system rooted in Indian ethos aligned with principles for transformation of India as a global superpower.

There is a panel discussion. Dr. Ajay Thube, Assistant Deputy Registrar, SPPU, Pune, Dr. Sukhdev Kadam, Dr. Vijay Raut, Dr. Dipak Sontakke, Dr. T.S. Thopate, Dr.R.N. Deshmukh, Dr. Raghunath Najan, Dr. S.R. Wagh, Mr.A.V. More, Dr. Yuvraj Waghere, Mrs. Rani Sonawane, Mr.Ranjit Shinde and other participants actively participated in the discussion. There is interaction with the participants on the various issues raised.

In the Valedictory session, Hon. Shri Nandkumar Zaware Patil, President Ahmednagar Jilha Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj, Ahmednagar delivered the presidential address. He highlighted the need to master the basic skills as well as soft and life skills. New Education Policy needs to be implemented effectively for having more qualitative knowledge and better career opportunities. We must impart the traditional as well as new courses and subjects to mould citizens to adapt with new changes in the global education system. The New Education Policy offers freedom to learners but the government laid down too many restrictions on it. It seems to be orthodoxia. We must contemplate and raise our voices against it. The best way to overcome it, is to implement New Education Policy effectively.



In the Valedictory session, there was feedback from participants. At the end, Ashok More conveyed a Vote of thanks.



28.State-of-the-art Infrastructure facilities are created from the support of various funding agencies.


