



#### Scope:





#### **Introduction:**

New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Parner is an affiliated college of SPPU, Pune. It is catering the diversified educational needs of all kind of learners. HEI provides an inclusive environment for the different sections of the learner society including physically challenged as well as persons with the disabilities. College formulated a policy on the basis of National Policy of GoI 2006 and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 which deals with educational rehabilitation of persons with disabilities. HEI's policy recognizes that persons with disabilities are valuable human resource for the institution and seeks to create an environment that provides equal opportunities, protection of their rights and full participation in the academic environment.

#### **Objectives:**

- 1. To have the building with ramps, railings and lifts.
- 2. To provide the accessible, gender-sensitive, safe, usable and functional washroom facilities.
- 3. To use/install the proper text and pictogram signage such as tactile path, lights, display boards, signposts to be visible and touchable.
- 4. To use of signage of male and female symbols, in accordance with local customs and standards, with raised outlines and bright color contrast will be more evident to everyone and particularly helpful for persons with visual impairments.
- 5. To support learners adequately and appropriately in and out of the classroom with the right resources and assistive technology, and with leadership, teaching staff and college communities that are responsive to their needs.
- 6. To ensure the accessibility of software tools and technology for the people with disabilities.
- 7. Provision for enquiry and information: Human assistance, reader, scribe, soft copies of reading material, screen reading.

- 2. Teaching and non-teaching Staff;
- 3. Other Stakeholders of HEI such as alumni, parents, visitors, etc.

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
#### **Guiding Principles:**

HEI provided barrier-free environment where people with disabilities can move about safely and freely and use the facilities within the built environment. The environment supports the independent functioning of individuals so that they can participate without assistance in everyday activities within the campus.

- 1. HEI established ramps, and railings for every building for the free movement.
- 2. College buildings have provision of lift for barrier free access for students, staff, visitors and differently abled people. There are two lifts; one in Bldg. No. 1 and the other in Bldg. No. 3.
- 3. Differently abled friendly restrooms are established. These accessible restrooms carry the fixtures and fittings that are comfortable and convenient to the differently abled people.
- 4. Screen reader is an assistive software programme which helps the visually impaired or the blind to work with computer. The Non Visual Desktop Access (NVDA) is free; open-source software.
- 5. NVDA and Braille softwares are installed in the computers at Library to help the visually challenged students in learning. Audio Books are also made available in library.
- 6. Classes for Divyangjan are conducted at ground floor only.
- 7. A wheelchair is made available for easy movement.
- 8. Signage boards are fixed at appropriate places.
- 9. Institute offers 5% reservation for persons with disabilities in all the courses offered by Institute.
- 10. The scribe facility is made available for differently-abled student in the examination as per the SPPU, Pune.
- 11. If necessary, the separate sitting arrangement would be for the differently-abled student.
- 12. Programmes are conducted in the institution for the differently- abled to encourage them in the college events.
- 13. They are also motivated to participate in the programmes organized by other institutes.
- 14. The institution has a supporting staff to help the differently-abled person in urgent need for movement from one place to other.
- 15. The college fee is waived off for the differently-abled student.
- 16. Exam fee is also waived off to the differently-abled student.
- 17. Counselling to differently-abled students on the types of courses they could study.








Picture 90: Sample Image of the Magazine "Prakshwata"

# Brief Report of the Facilities at HEI (AY 2017-18 to 2021-22)

#### [Environmental Consciousness and Sustainability and Divyangjan friendly Initiatives]

New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Parner strives to provide the quality education as per the vision and mission statement. The college has identified the areas of sensitization of students in context with environment, energy, sustainability, inclusiveness and provided a conducive environment through the facilities in tune with the Perspective plan, policies, and procedures. This helped in accepting the challenges of 21<sup>st</sup> century and NEP 2020 to undertake initiatives to address glocal (Global and Local) issues. The role of institute is reflected in terms of various programmes and activities incorporating within its regular functioning. The Institution has facilities and initiatives for the following:

#### 1. Alternate sources of energy and energy conservation measures:

The College has facilities for alternate sources of energy and implemented various energy conservation measures in terms of use of solar photovoltaic cell, solar water heater, sensorbased illumination system, use of power efficient equipment's and LED, biogas, etc.

A. Photovoltaic cells or rooftop solar panels and wheeled to grid:

To save the cost on energy expenditure, Institute has installed Photovoltaic cells or rooftop solar panels of 61 kW capacities on the buildings. Some of solar panels of (30kW) of the facilities are wheeled to the grid (3 Unites) of electricity provider Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (MSEDCL), a state government company.

- **B.** Solar water heater: Several solar water heater units with a total working capacity of 3,385 litres have been installed at various locations within the campus to save the electricity consumption and expenditure of the institute. Two demo units (Flat plate collector and Evacuated tube collector) are being placed at the science building as a learning module for the students who opted for B. Voc. in RETM.
- C. Sensor Based Energy Conservation: The institute has placed the RADAR motion sensor LED bulbs (06 nos.) in certain places like storerooms and washrooms. The college has also installed 08 nos. of sensor based street lights in the premises for illumination in night time.
- **D.** Use of LED bulbs/ Energy efficient equipment: The HEI is using CFL, LED, starrated power equipment, etc. which consumes lesser electricity. Institute procures electrical equipment (such as refrigerator and AC) which has an energy star rating as per the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) standard which ensures relatively lesser consumption of electricity. The institute has installed the LED light on the whole campus for low consumption of energy and replaced the old light systems with the help of an agency hired by the parent institute.

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# 2. Management of the various types of degradable and non-degradable waste

The HEI employs several techniques for the management of various types of degradable and non-degradable waste. The primary aim is to reduce, reuse and recycle the waste. The institute has constituted a committee that deal with the minimization of waste. Following principles are followed for waste management:

- A. Biogas: The institute has functional biogas set up for generating alternative fuel from kitchen waste. Kitchen waste from Hostels, as well as leftover food from Campus canteens and expired food, is used to generate thermal energy for cooking and heating. The unit can be fed up with 5-10 kg of kitchen waste per day and a Gas Volume of 20 cubic meters.
- **B.** Use of Dustbins: Plentiful of dustbins are placed at various places in the premises for collection waste. The waste is segregated at the source only into dry and wet form.
- **C. Vermicomposting Units:** The organic waste produced in the college is subjected to vermicomposting. There are about 4 units of vermicomposting. The organic manure so produced is utilized for the fertilizing the trees and plantation in the college campus.
- **D. Water Treatment Plant:** The domestic effluent is treated with Sewage Treatment plant (STP) established in the college. The treated water is then used for watering to the plants and greenery in the premises. The wastage of water at the drinking water facility is utilized for watering the plants. The effluent waste generated from laboratories is controlled using innovative methods of experimentation and treated further using Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) established behind laboratories.
- **E.** Septic Tank: The ample of septic tanks are constructed adjacent to washrooms and hostels for collection and basic treatment to the sewage waste. The organic solids are settled and digested by anaerobic treatment. The separated liquid effluent is slowly discharged into the soak pits.

#### 3. Water Conservation

The HEI is located at Parner which is a draught prone area in Ahmednagar district with meagre rainfall. Therefore there is water scarcity year after the year. So policy makers have worked out strategies to conserve the water all the time. Every little bit attempt will help to conserve the water. As Responsible stakeholder, the college has developed following facilities for water conservation.

- a. Rainwater Harvesting and Bore Well Recharge: The roof top rainwater and surface run off within the campus are collected at all feasible points in the campus. The pavers block are placed to avoid soil erosion due to surface run off water but it also helps to recharge the ground water level. The college has also developed the facility for recharge of bore well by the use of harvested surface run off water due to rainfall.
- b. Waste Water Recycling with Sewage Treatment plant (STP) and septic tanks
- c. Construction of Tanks: The number of water tanks (total 21) have been constructed and mounted in the college premises to store the water (Total water storage capacity 2,60,000 Litres.). This helps to fulfil the need of water for laboratory purpose and domestic and grading use.
- d. Water Distribution System and Drip irrigation is employed for efficient use of available water.



- 4. Green Campus: The institutional facilities and initiatives for greening the campus are as follows:

  - c. HEI has constructed the pedestrian friendly pathways and roads by laying the pavers blocks in college premises.
  - d. A unique cactus garden with more than 150 saplings, a nursery and botanical garden with medicinal plants
  - e. "QR Coding of Plants" in the premises for access the information easily
  - f. Promotion for use of public transport and e-Vehicles
- 5. Disabled-friendly, barrier free environment: HEI has provided following facilities for the persons with disabilities (Divyangjan).
  - a. Built environment with ramps/lifts for easy access to classrooms: HEI has developed an infrastructure with raps and lifts to provide barrier free and inclusive environment the persons with disabilities (Divyangjan). The classes of students with disabilities (Divyangjan) are conducted on the ground floor only. The lift facility is also made reserved for them.
  - b. Disabled-friendly washrooms: These are available in college premises.
  - c. Signage including tactile path, lights, display boards and signposts: HEI has constructed the pedestrian friendly pathways and roads by laying the pavers blocks in college premises. The signage boards are placed at prominent places for assistance to person with disabilities (Divyangjan).
  - d. Assistive technology and facilities for persons with disabilities (*Divyangjan*): The NVDA Software is also installed to assist the Divyangjan with impaired vision for operating the computer. Magazine "Prakshwata" is subscribed in Knowledge Resource Centre (Central Library) for Divyangjan with impaired vision. The Brail software is also available for Divyangjan.
  - e. Human assistance, soft copies of reading material, screen reading: The human assistance is also provided to the persons with disabilities (Divyangjan) as per the requirement in the campus. The health centre is equipped with wheel chair, crunches, walker, etc. The central library is equipped with Echo Dot, a voice-controlled Smart Speaker with Alexa.
  - f. Reader and Scribe: The scribe facility is also available to the person with disabilities at time of examination as per the need.
  - g. Common Room/Restroom: This has made available to available for Divyangjan.
