Policy on Green Campus, Environment & Energy Usage

Introduction:

“Earth provides enough to satisfy every man's needs, but not every man's greed.”

The progress and development have led to the deterioration of nature. In the quest for fulfilling man's needs, he has exploited nature to its maximum. This development is not ecologically sustainable. Awareness about the degradation of nature with implementation of strategies to conserve it becomes more important for the sustainable development. We believe that, higher education institutes can play an important role in development of responsible youths.

New Arts, Commerce and Science College, Parner is located in a rain shadow region that receives scanty rainfall. We have adopted the environment friendly practices along with curricular and co-curricular activities to develop a green and eco-friendly campus. This offers a lead to the institution to redefining its environmental culture and development of new paradigms by creating sustainable solutions to environmental, social and economic needs of the mankind.

It was necessary to look forward to make the efficient use of available water and other resources. A clean and healthy environment aids effective learning and provides a conducive learning environment. We decided to educate and make aware students on the issues such as renewable energy sources, waste management and water conservation. HEI works in the areas of energy, environment, and waste management. The stakeholders work to develop an eco-friendly, sustainable campus and to disseminate the concept of green campus.

Scope:

The policies on green campus, energy and environment will develop new practices that encourage stakeholders to take lead in creating positive change for sustainable development. This initiative helps to review all infrastructural and administrative functions from the stand points of eco-friendly, energy conservation and sustainable environment in and around the college premises.

3. To use of available water efficiently
4. To manage the waste properly.
5. To work with all stakeholders and local community.

Guiding Principles:

HEI resolved to work with stakeholders to foster a culture of self-sustainability and eco-friendly campus. The time bound strategies are developed to implement green campus initiatives. At the outset, committees comprising faculty from the various departments are constituted in consultation of IQAC. It was entrusted the task of formulating principles for clean and green campus. The committee plans and executes initiatives as follows:

1. Conduct a green, environmental, electrical and fire safety and energy audit of the campus periodically.
2. Celebration of “*Vanmahostav*” and plantation of different plant species at defined intervals with the help of stakeholders.
3. Sensitization of the stakeholders to minimize the use of polluting products and use proper environment-friendly substitutes and services.
4. Ingrain the importance of cleanliness for a healthy life through *Swachhata Pandharwada* and *Swachh Bharat Abhiyan*.
5. Use of energy efficient equipment’s [BEE Energy STAR rating] at workplace.
6. Awareness about environmental issues by organizing Events, Rallies, Awareness Campaigns, Cleanliness Drives, Seminars, Workshops, presentations, Tree Plantation



Drives, Wildlife Photography Competitions, Rangoli Competitions, Essay Competitions, Bird Watching Programs, Excursions, Study Tours, Guest Lectures, Talks, etc.

7. Initiatives to implement the Clean and Green Campus Policy.

Environment and eco-friendly/green campus

- Increase of green cover in and around the campus by plantation.
- Development of Cactus garden to conserve local and exotic xerophytic plant species.
- Construction of pedestrian friendly roads in the campus with help of paver blocks.
- Development of botanical garden and nursery of medicinal plants.

Energy Conservation:

- Suitable action taken to reduce greenhouse gas emissions due to energy consumption
 - To use of energy efficient lamps (LED)/sensor based lamps (RADAR/IR/ Light) where ever possible like corridors, toilets, store room, etc.
 - To use of energy efficient equipment's (BEE STAR) in laboratories/ classrooms/ canteen.
 - Use of solar water heaters.
- Monitoring the entry of vehicles in the college in terms of their fuel efficiency and encourage the use of battery operated vehicles.
- Promoting the use of public transport system.
- Creating awareness by organizing seminars, workshop, debates, essay competition activities related to climate change, environmental protection, and environmental issues.
- Promoting projects and experiments in the education system as part of regular curriculum which is related to environmental aspects.
- Actions taken to reduce Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions.

Waste Management

- Adoption of methods for waste segregation at source in the form of dry and wet with help of dustbins.
- Use of vermicomposting units for disposal of organic waste and production of organic manure to fertilize the trees.
- Take appropriate actions to reduce and recycle waste.
- Establishment of MoUs and agreements to manage, collect and dispose waste, e-waste, scrape, etc. appropriately.



- Generation of biogas from waste food.
- Actions taken for minimize the use of plastic by following 4 'R' principle viz., refuse, reduce, reuse and recycle.
- Adoption for paperless/less paper work culture and recycling/ reuse of paper in administration.

Water Management

- Adopting following measures on campus to reduce water consumption
 - Rain water harvesting.
 - Drip irrigation for watering the plants.
 - Use of STP to treat the domestic/laboratory effluent.
 - Use of recycled water for watering the plants.
 - Use of innovative methods of experimentation.
- Use of septic tanks and soak pits.
- Safe and Clean Potable Water using water purification systems
- Use of water efficient taps.

HEI practiced to display of instructions/alerts/ slogans at prominent locations in the campus for conservation of water, energy and waste management for sustainable development.

4. Report of Environmental Promotional Activities Conducted Beyond the Campus

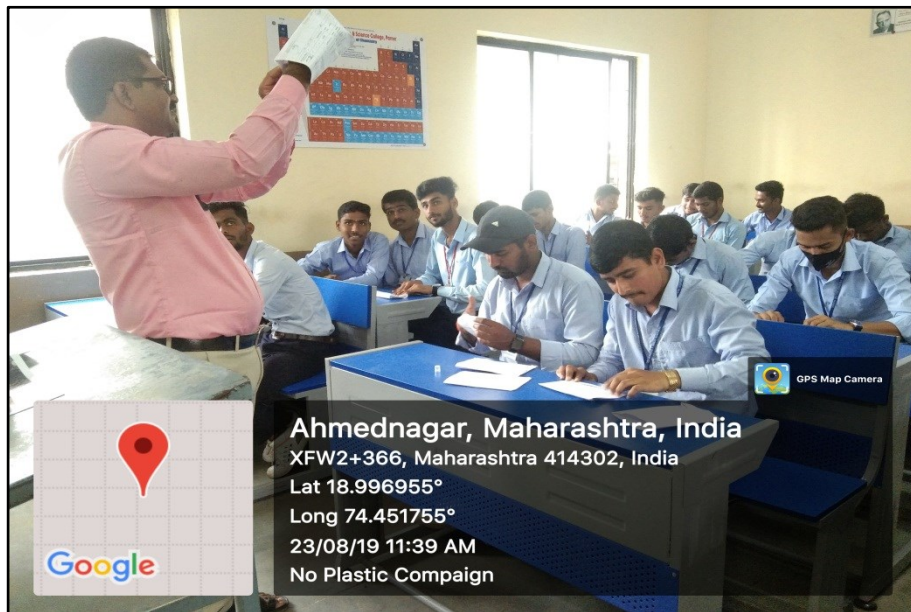

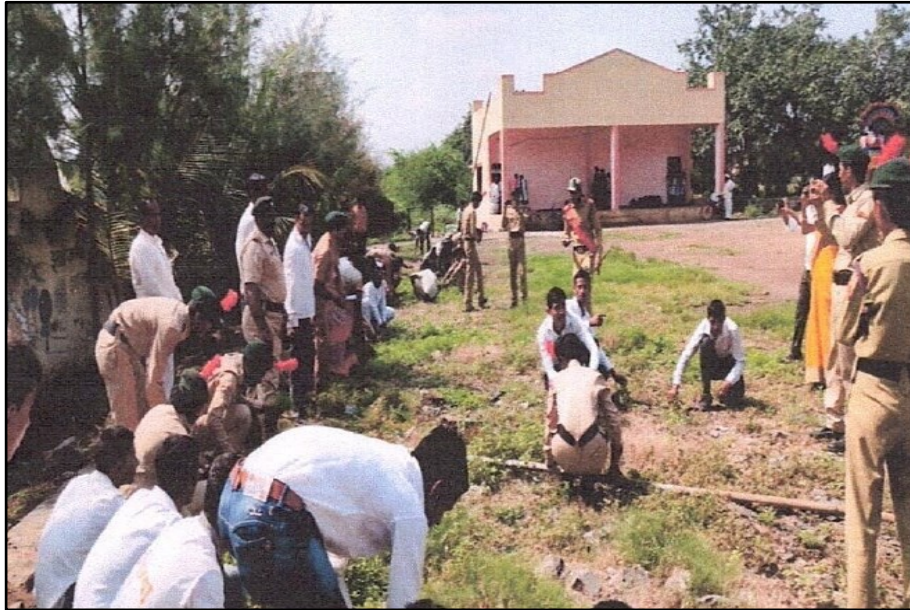

2. Achievement through Clean and green campus initiatives

A. Minimize the Energy expenditure through In-house energy audit and use of Solar PV System, Solar Water Heaters and Biogas:

The in-house energy audit is carried out by the Department of B. Voc. (RETM) on regular basis to introspect about energy consumption and expenditure of the institute. Now a day, HEI meets 33% of its energy consumption from non-conventional energy sources, particularly from use of solar panel. This helps to minimize the expenditure on the energy consumption.

Several solar water heater units with a total working capacity of **3,385 litres** have been installed at various locations within the campus to save the electricity consumption and expenditure of the institute.

The biogas, a substitute for LPG, is be produced from food waste, decomposable organic material, and kitchen waste using the biogas set up. This helps to not only minimize the energy expenditure but also to manage the solid waste.

The institute has placed the RADAR motion sensor LED bulbs in certain places like storerooms and washrooms. The replacement of old conventional lights with LED, use of sensor-based LED street lights and use of Power efficient equipment’s also help to minimize the cost on energy expenditure.

B. Use of e-Vehicles: Students became aware about efforts of HEI about the energy conservation and environmental cautiousness. Total 15 student right now have battery powered vehicles /e-bikes. The college promote the use of these kinds of vehicles by felicitation with books.

C. Green Campus: The various strategies to conserve the water helped to make the optimal use of available water and to develop the green and eco-friendly campus. A unique cactus garden with more than 150 saplings, a nursery and botanical garden with medicinal plants are the outcomes of our sincere efforts towards the Green Campus initiatives of HEI.
